

## **IF YOU ARE** INJURED **ON THE JOB**

You must take certain steps if you are injured on the job. Follow the steps below.

## **STEPS TO TAKE**

- Notify your supervisor immediately. Your employer is required to file an 5 Employer's-Report-of-Injury-or-Illness form within seven days.
- Seek medical treatment. Use your company's designated physician listed below for all non-emergency injuries as soon as possible. Please give your company's policy number to your medical provider.
- Keep in contact with your employer. Continually inform your employer of your condition and work capabilities.
- Review your rights and responsibilities. Workers' compensation insurance covers the following benefits for work-related accidents: + Reasonable and necessary medical treatment
  - - + Compensation for lost wages
    - + Mileage reimbursement for travel to medical appointments
    - + Prescription drugs
