

Switchpoint Vehicle Driver Agreement

I understand and agree to the following:

- Prior to driving an agency vehicle, I must have a valid Utah State driver license in my possession.
- Approved drivers will have no more than 3 moving violations or will not be eligible to drive Switchpoint vehicles.
- Switchpoint vehicles are restricted to business use only.
- I am responsible for buckling my seatbelt prior to moving the vehicle.
- I am responsible for ensuring that all passengers are buckled before moving the vehicle.
- I will not text and drive.
- Cell phone is for emergency use only and will not be used while the vehicle is in motion unless a hands-free device
 is available. Should I receive a phone call without the availability of a hands-free device I will not respond until the
 vehicle is parked.
- Personal use of the vehicle will be considered upon prior approval of the executive director.
- I am expected to honor all road signs and laws.
- Any violations, including moving and parking, are the sole responsibility of the driver.
- As a driver of the vehicle, I am responsible to report all repair and maintenance concerns to the finance department.
- I am responsible for keeping the vehicle clean and shall not allow it to become unsightly or offensive.
- Service animals are the only animals allowed in the vehicle.
- I am responsible for tracking data, mileage, and destination as required on the mileage log.
- I shall not allow unauthorized persons to drive the vehicle.
- When the gas tank has 50% of fuel left, I am responsible for filling the vehicle and submitting a corresponding receipt with mileage notated to the finance department.
- Switchpoint will maintain comprehensive and liability insurance coverage for the vehicles and named drivers. Passengers are also covered by insurance.
- In the event of any accident, please refer to the CARD in the vehicle titled: After a Car Accident
 - My first priority is the safety of myself and any passengers
 - I will contact appropriate law enforcement authorities
 - I will contact management at Switchpoint and document damage.
 - I will complete an incident report and submit to Finance and HR within 12 hours.
 - I will undergo a Medical Exam (even if I feel fine) within 90 minutes of the accident at the nearest WorkMed location.
 - As required, I will complete a Drug Test within 90 minutes of the accident at the nearest WorkMed location.
- Switchpoint will be responsible for damages. However, should an investigation show that the vehicle was being used outside of the scope of employment the employee may be liable for the accident and may be forced to take legal and/or financial responsibility for any damage, accident, or injury.
- If an employee/driver is found at fault in an accident, their Switchpoint driving privileges will subject to termination, and they may not be able to drive Switchpoint vehicles in the future.



Should I violate any of the above requirements I will be subject to disciplinary action which may susp	end my
organization vehicle driving privileges, and up to, or including termination.
